Jesus Sends the 70 (Luke 10:1-24 – Jesus' Ministry #7
Sunday, May 24, 2026

A people sent with ***His purpose***,

Strengthened by ***His authority***, and

Invited to ***rejoice in Him***.

Jesus sends us with His purpose

After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go. Luke 10:1 NKJV

Then He said to them, “The harvest truly *is* great, but the laborers *are* few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. Luke 10:2 NKJV

Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves. Luke 10:3 NKJV

Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road. Luke 10:4 NKJV

But whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house.' Luke 10:5 NKJV

And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you. Luke 10:6 NKJV

And remain in the same house, eating and drinking such things as they give, for the laborer is worthy of his wages. Do not go from house to house. Luke 10:7 NKJV

Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you. Luke 10:8 NKJV

And heal the sick there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' Luke 10:9 NKJV

Jesus strengthens us with His authority

But whatever city you enter, and they do not receive you, go out into its streets and say, Luke 10:10 NKJV

The very dust of your city which clings to us we wipe off against you. Nevertheless know this, that the kingdom of God has come near you.' Luke 10:11 NKJV

But I say to you that it will be more tolerable in that Day for Sodom than for that city. Luke 10:12 NKJV

"Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago, sitting in sackcloth and ashes. Luke 10:13 NKJV

But it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the judgment than for you. Luke 10:14 NKJV

And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades. Luke 10:15 NKJV

He who hears you hears Me, he who rejects you rejects Me, and he who rejects Me rejects Him who sent Me." Luke 10:16 NKJV

Then the seventy returned with joy, saying, "Lord, even the demons are subject to us in Your name." Luke 10:17 NKJV

And He said to them, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Luke 10:18 NKJV

Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you. Luke 10:19 NKJV

Jesus encourages us to rejoice in Him

Nevertheless do not rejoice in this, that the spirits are subject to you, but rather rejoice because your names are written in heaven.” Luke 10:20 NKJV

In that hour **Jesus** rejoiced in **the Spirit** and said, “I thank You, **Father**, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from *the* wise and prudent and revealed them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. Luke 10:21 NKJV

All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the Son, and *the one* to whom the Son wills to reveal *Him*.” Luke 10:22 NKJV

Then He turned to *His* disciples and said privately, “Blessed *are* the eyes which see the things you see; Luke 10:23 NKJV

for I tell you that many prophets and kings have desired to see what you see, and have not seen *it*, and to hear what you hear, and have not heard *it*.” Luke 10:24 NKJV

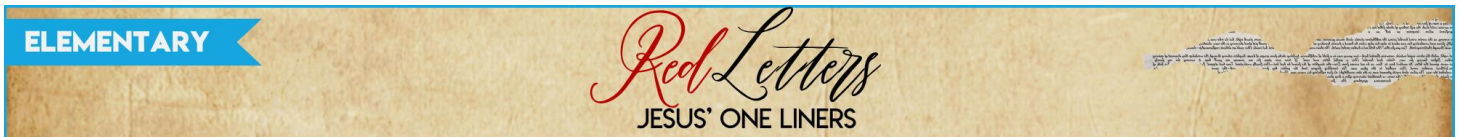
