Jesus Sends the 12 (Luke 9:1-36) – Jesus' Ministry #5

that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, Philippians 3:10 NKJV

Jesus brings his Kingdom through people who fully depend on Him

Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. Luke 9:1 NKJV

He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick. Luke 9:2 NKJV

And He said to them, "Take nothing for the journey, neither staffs nor bag nor bread nor money; and do not have two tunics apiece. Luke 9:3 NKJV

Jesus brings his Kingdom through people who radically surrender to Him

And He strictly warned and commanded them to tell this to no one, Luke 9:21 NKJV

saying, "The Son of Man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day." Luke 9:22 NKJV

Then He said to *them* all, “If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. Luke 9:23 NKJV

For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it. Luke 9:24 NKJV

For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself destroyed or lost? Luke 9:25 NKJV

Now it came to pass, about eight days after these sayings, that He took Peter, John, and James and went up on the mountain to pray. Luke 9:28 NKJV

As He prayed, the appearance of His face was altered, and His robe *became* white *and* glistening. Luke 9:29 NKJV

And behold, two men talked with Him, who were Moses and Elijah, Luke 9:30 NKJV
who appeared in glory and spoke of His decease which He was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. Luke 9:31 NKJV

While he was saying this, a cloud came and overshadowed them; and they were fearful as they entered the cloud. Luke 9:34 NKJV

And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, “This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!” Luke 9:35 NKJV

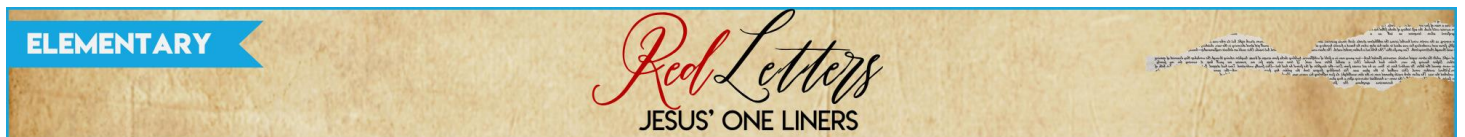

Memory Verse: "Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit." Matthew 28:19

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Saves | Acts 9

Parent Connect: Today we learned how Saul became Paul after he became a Christian. We learned how God blinded Saul before he became a follower of Jesus. Play a game of "Hide and Seek" with your kid, pretending to be Saul as you count with your eyes closed!



Jesus had some drop the mic one liner, unforgettable moments. He said things that were so counter-cultural and life changing in just one sentence. In this series we will unpack four of those one-liners.

Parent Connect:

- Read: Luke 9:1–36
- Talk: There were several short stories in the reading today. Choose one to go over again and talk about what being there might have been like.
- Do: Use a web browser to search the location of the Sea of Galilee in northern Israel. The area surrounding this freshwater lake was where Jesus did much of his ministry.

DAY IN THE LIFE

Over the next seven weeks we are stepping back into A Day in the Life of Jesus from calling his disciples to sending out the 70. He prepared others to carry the message forward, and that includes us! As we spend this time walking through a day in Jesus' life we will ask what it looks like to follow Him daily.

Memory Verse: **“But he replied, ‘I must preach the Good News of the Kingdom of God in other towns, too, because that is why I was sent.’” Luke 4:43**

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus calls us to depend on Him – Luke 9:1-36

Parent Connect: This week in G56 we talked about how Jesus sent his 12 disciples out. If you have sent your student out on their own to go to the grocery store or gas station, or to a friend's house by themselves, talk about how that first experience went. If you are about to embark on this journey, talk about how prepared your student is, and how your teaching has prepared them for that errand or adventure.
