**Life in Jesus starts with humility**

Then Jesus gave the following illustration: “Can one blind person lead another? Won’t they both fall into a ditch? Luke 6:39 NLT

Students are not greater than their teacher. But the student who is fully trained will become like the teacher. Luke 6:40 NLT

“And why worry about a speck in your friend’s eye when you have a log in your own? Luke 6:41 NLT

How can you think of saying, ‘Friend, let me help you get rid of that speck in your eye,’ when you can’t see past the log in your own eye? Hypocrite! First get rid of the log in your own eye; then you will see well enough to deal with the speck in your friend’s eye. Luke 6:42 NLT

## **Life in Jesus addresses the heart before behavior**

“A good tree can’t produce bad fruit, and a bad tree can’t produce good fruit. Luke 6:43 NLT

A tree is identified by its fruit. Figs are never gathered from thornbushes, and grapes are not picked from bramble bushes. Luke 6:44 NLT

A good person produces good things from the treasury of a good heart, and an evil person produces evil things from the treasury of an evil heart. What you say flows from what is in your heart. Luke 6:45 NLT

## **Life in Jesus is founded to withstand any storm**

“So why do you keep calling me ‘Lord, Lord!’ when you don’t do what I say? Luke 6:46 NLT

I will show you what it’s like when someone comes to me, listens to my teaching, and then follows it. Luke 6:47 NLT

It is like a person building a house who digs deep and lays the foundation on solid rock. When the floodwaters rise and break against that house, it stands firm because it is well built. Luke 6:48 NLT

But anyone who hears and doesn’t obey is like a person who builds a house right on the ground, without a foundation. When the floods sweep down against that house, it will collapse into a heap of ruins.” Luke 6:49 NLT
