

#### On the Road to Emmaus – Easter April 9, 2023

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#### Do you believe Jesus is alive?

"Jesus, a wise man... doer of wonderful works... teacher... appeared to them alive..." (<u>Antiquities of the Jews</u>, Josephus, 93 AD)

"Christus, from whom ["Christians"] had its origin, suffered the extreme penalty during... reign of Tiberius" (*Annals*, Tacitus, 116 AD)

So it was, while they conversed and reasoned, that Jesus Himself drew near and went with them. (Luke 24:15)

But their eyes were restrained, so that they did not know Him. Luke 24:16 NKJV

And He said to them, "What kind of conversation *is* this that you have with one another as you walk and are sad?" **Luke 24:17 NKJV** 

Then the one whose name was Cleopas answered and said to Him, "Are You the only stranger in Jerusalem, and have You not known the things which happened there in these days?" **Luke 24:18 NKJV** 

#### Jesus' resurrection ends our hopelessness

And He said to them, "What things?" So they said to Him, "The things concerning Jesus of Nazareth, who was a Prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, **Luke 24:19 NKJV** 

and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be condemned to death, and crucified Him. Luke 24:20 NKJV

But we were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel. Indeed, besides all this, today is the third day since these things happened. **Luke 24:21 NKJV** 

#### Jesus' resurrection changes our expectations

Then He said to them, "O foolish ones, and add slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! **Luke 24:25 NKJV** 

Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?" Luke 24:26 NKJV

And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself. Luke 24:27 NKJV

#### Jesus' resurrection builds our confidence in the Bible

Now it came to pass, as He sat at the table with them, that He took bread, blessed and broke *it*, and gave it to them. **Luke 24:30 NKJV** 

Then their eyes were opened and they knew Him; and He vanished from their sight. Luke 24:31 NKJV

And they said to one another, "Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?" **Luke 24:32 NKJV** 

So they rose up that very hour and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven and those who were with them gathered together, **Luke 24:33 NKJV** 

saying, "The Lord is risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!" Luke 24:34 NKJV

And they told about the things *that had happened* on the road, and how He was known to them in the breaking of bread. **Luke 24:35 NKJV**

#### 5. The miracle of the Church

- 1. Growth From 120 (Acts 1) to 15k (Acts 4) to 250k (Few Years) to 2.2 Billion (Today)

# HOW DO I KNOW I HAVE JESUS AND HELP OTHERS KNOW JESUS?



The main theme of the book of 1 John is the word "KNOW". In this series, we will be following the adults series "Signs of Life" to understand how we can KNOW that we have Jesus, and help others KNOW Him too!

**Memory Verse**: I have written this to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know you have eternal life. 1 John 5:13

Heart of the Lesson: Do you know Jesus is Alive? - Luke 24:13-35

**Parent Connect:** Jesus' followers were walking with Jesus after He died and rose again, but they didn't even recognize Him. Put your sticker somewhere to remind you that Jesus is Alive and with you.



Jesus is risen! This Easter, we're taking time to look at the truth that Jesus came and lived a perfect life, died, and rose again. When we see the truth of the Good News of Jesus, our hearts are changed, and we respond by sharing Jesus with other people!
