Memory Verse: "God Made Me" Genesis 1:27-28

Heart of the Lesson: God Made Me with Hands and Fee

Parent Connect: Hang today's craft somewhere where your kid will see it throughout the week. Intentionally point it out this week to remind your kid that "god made them with hands and feet and God made them special."

Heart of the Lesson: David and Abigail | 1 Samuel 25

Parent Connect: Today we learned about how Abigail showed kindness to David by giving him food. Help your kid show kindness and allow them to help you make a meal, prep dinner, make a snake and share with someone else.

Heart of the Lesson: God's Kingdom is Made Up of People Who Follow Him - Matthew 6:9-13b; Colossians 1:13-14

Parent Connect: We're about halfway through our Lord's Prayer series! Take some time read this prayer together in different versions of the Bible using a Bible App. As a family work on starting to memorize this prayer together!



In This series, we will be following along with the Adults to walk through The Lord's Prayer. We will go through the prayer verse by verse, learning about the example Jesus gives, how it applies to our lives and how we can pray. Students will also learn how to implement and practice the practical tips that Jesus shares: asking for forgiveness, praising God in prayer, thanking Him for supplying for our needs, praying for His kingdom to come and His will to be done.

Heart of the Lesson: God gives us what we need-Matthew 6:11

Parent Connect: Make a collage of things that you need (i.e. toothbrush, bed, clothes, food, shelter, transportation) and put them on a poster where you eat or spend time together as a family. Thank God for providing what you need.

Just like we want to talk to our close friends and family, God wants us to talk to Him! Prayer is what we call talking with God. But it can be confusing to know what to pray about! Luckily, Jesus showed us how! This series, we're looking at a sample prayer Jesus prayed to learn how we can pray!

Memory Verse: "This is how you should pray. "'Our Father in heaven, may your name be honored. May your kingdom come. May what you want to happen be done on earth as it is done in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our sins, just as we also have forgiven those who sin against us. Keep us from sinning when we are tempted. Save us from the evil one.' [For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.] (Matthew 6:9-13)

Heart of the Lesson: Our Father provides for us (James 1:17, Job 1:21, 1 Chronicles 29:1, Matthew 6:31-34, & Philippians 4:11-13,19)
