Heart of the Lesson: God Watches Over Us Because He Loves Us

Parent Connection: Play flashlight hide and seek as a family. Let the person seeking use a flashlight to find the hiders. When you're done playing say:

- Who watches over us day and night?
- God watches over us!

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus shows God's power and glory - Luke 5:1-11; 27-32, and many more

Parent Connect: Fill up the bathtub or go to the pool and try walking on water.

Heart of the Lesson: Honoring Your Parents - Ezekiel 36:26

Parent Connect: Today we asked, "What if my friend wants to believe in Jesus but her parents don't want her to? Or don't want her to come to church?" Ask your student if they have any friends whose parents won't let them come to church or won't let them hear about Jesus. Join your student in praying over these families that their hearts would be softened towards learning about Jesus. If you aren't sure what to pray, consider praying Ezekiel 36:26 over that family.
