4 Approaches to “Days”

- Literal 24 hours
- Literal time period
- Metaphorical
- Mythological

Jesus answered and said to them, “Are you not therefore mistaken, because you do not know the Scriptures nor the power of God? **Mark 12:24 NKJV**

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. **Genesis 1:1 NKJV**

The earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. **Genesis 1:2 NKJV**

Then God said, “Let there be light”; and there was light. **Genesis 1:3 NKJV**

And God saw the light, that *it was* good; and God divided the light from the darkness. **Genesis 1:4 NKJV**

God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. So the evening and the morning were the first day. **Genesis 1:5 NKJV**

Thus God made the firmament, and divided the waters which *were* under the firmament from the waters which *were* above the firmament; and it was so. **Genesis 1:7 NKJV**

Then God said, “Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb *that* yields seed, *and* the fruit tree *that* yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed *is* in itself, on the earth”; and it was so. **Genesis 1:11 NKJV**

Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. *He made* the stars also. **Genesis 1:16 NKJV**

So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that *it was* good. **Genesis 1:21 NKJV**

Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” **Genesis 1:26 NKJV**

So God created man in His *own* image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. **Genesis 1:27 NKJV**

Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.” **Genesis 1:28 NKJV**

Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed *it was* very good. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day. **Genesis 1:31 NKJV**

Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were finished. **Genesis 2:1 NKJV**

And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had done, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done. **Genesis 2:2 NKJV**

Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which God had created and made. **Genesis 2:3 NKJV**

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Helps Sick People

Parent Engagement: Ask your kid, “**How do you feel when you are sick?**” and “**Who helps people when they’re sick?**” Remind the kids that **Jesus helps sick people just as he helped the man in the Bible story.** Reread today’s Bible story from a kid’s Bible with your toddler.

Heart of the Lesson: Creation - “God’s plan from the Beginning” - Genesis 1-2:4

Parent Engagement: Spend some time with your kids memorizing the 7 days of creation and talk about where you saw them throughout your day (ex. Day 5-A bird pooped on my car which reminds me God made the birds)



During this series, we're going to be looking at some early stories of the Bible and how God was the author orchestrating them. We will spend Large Group time looking at the story itself, and then asking where Jesus is during Small Groups.

Memory Verse: For ever since the world was created, people have seen the earth and sky. Through everything God made, they can clearly see his invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature. So they have no excuse for not knowing God. Romans 1:20
