
Focusing on God throughout your day

Heart of the Lesson: Our friend Jesus Cares for Us

Parent Connect: Ask your kid to retell today's story using the craft we made in class.

Heart of the Lesson: John the Baptist | Luke 1:5-25, 57-66, Luke 3:1-20, Matthew 3:1-12

Parent Connect: Today we learned how John the Baptist was to prepare the way for Jesus! Talk to your kid on how they would prepare to talk to someone special! Would they practice what they would say? Would they write it down? Say a prayer with your kid asking God to prepare your hearts to learn more about Jesus!



How does God see the world? How does God see us? How can we use scripture to see things differently? In this 3-D themed series, we are going to tackle all of those questions, and more, as we dive into learning how to see as God sees.

Heart of the Lesson: Seeing As God Sees | 1 Samuel 16:7

Parent Connect: Today, we learned how God sees things that we don't automatically see. Use the 3-D glasses your child got in Kid's Worship and look at some 3-D images. Ask what they see both with and without the glasses on. Talk about how God looks at the heart while we sometimes just look at the surface level. Highlight that we can train ourselves to see beyond the first impression.
