Memory Verse: "God made the World" Genesis 1:1 (Adapted for Toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: God Made the Sea

Parent Connect: Fill a shallow tub with water and bath toys. Discuss how God made the sea as you play together in the water.



This series will go into the different ways different people decided to listen to God and to follow His plan for them!

Memory Verse: "The angel of the Lord appeared to him and said, 'Mighty hero, the Lord is with you!'" Judges 6:12

Heart of the Lesson: Deborah – Judges 4-5

Parent Connect: Today we learned about Deborah who was a judge and God spoke to her while sitting under a palm tree – saying to go speak to Barak about following God's instructions. Go outside with your kid and sit under a tree. Talk about ways you can follow God, too!



The church needs to focus inward, outward, upward, and backward. In this series we'll use the popular game 'Dance Dance Revolution' to help us understand these concepts.

Memory Verse: The Lord directs the steps of the godly. He delights in every detail of their lives. 1 John 2:6

Heart of the Lesson: People in the Church Help Each Other - Acts 2:41-47

Parent Connect: Today we learned how important it is to help the people around us. Talk as a family and decide who your family is going to intentionally help this week. We can't wait to hear your stories!

This month we are looking at four aspects, the "DNA" of the church. We will look inward – how we help each other grow spiritually within the church outward – sharing Jesus with the world, upward – focusing our eyes on Jesus and Heaven, and backward – going back to the promise God made for the church.

Memory Verse: "Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near." Hebrews 10:24-25

Heart of the Lesson: Inward – The Church helps each other (Acts 2:41-47 – The Church at Jerusalem)

Parent Connect: Consider doing a RAK (random act of kindness) for a family at church that your family connects with. You can also talk about people that have helped your family from church and friends from church that your family has helped.
