Heart of the Lesson: God Keeps Us Safe Wherever We Are

Parent Connect: Today we learned that God keeps us safe and protects our families. Take a family walk and ask your toddler to show you how to be safe while you walk. Discuss with them that God teaches us safety and keeps us safe.



In this series, kids will learn that no matter what happens – whether we’re doing big things for God like Josiah, making mistakes like Jonah, feeling sad like the people of Jerusalem or standing strong like Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego- God is with us!

Heart of the Lesson: Jonah | Jonah 1-3

Heart of the Lesson: I Am Adopted | Ephesians 1

Parent Connect: Today, your kid adopted a rubber ducky! Ask all about their rubber ducky and see if they can explain how them adopting their duck is like how God adopts us into his family. When we make the choice to follow Jesus, we are adopted into his heavenly family!

We are all uniquely created by God, and each follower of Jesus is given a unique set of spiritual gifts meant to be used for His glory. In this series, students will discover their identity in Jesus, explore the gifts God has given them, and learn how to use those gifts to serve Him and others. We will end the series with Response Stations to reinforce everything we learned!
