The Church is Jesus' Bride

After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God! **Revelation 19:1 NKJV**

For true and righteous are His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her." **Revelation 19:2 NKJV**

Again they said, "Alleluia! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!" Revelation 19:3 NKJV

Jesus "proposes" when people hear the Gospel

In this series, we learn that God made the world we live in. He made land, sky, sea and plants!

Memory Verse: "God made the World" Genesis 1:1 (Adapted for Toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: God Made the Sky

Parent Connect: Watch a sunrise or a sunset together as a family or drive out of town away from the city lights and go stargazing. talk with your toddler about how God made the sky and everything in it (sun, moon, stars, etc).



This series will go into the different ways different people decided to listen to God and to follow His plan for them!

Memory Verse: "The angel of the Lord appeared to him and said, 'Mighty hero, the Lord is with you!'" Judges 6:12

Heart of the Lesson: Ruth and Boaz | Ruth 1-4

Parent Connect: Today we learned about Ruth and Naomi and how Ruth was a good friend. Talk to your kids about what makes a good friend, things like; being kind, taking turns, sharing toys. Draw with your kid on a piece of paper and make a picture to share with their friend. Pray and thank God together for friends!



The church needs to focus inward, outward, upward, and backward. In this series we'll use the popular game 'Dance Dance Revolution' to help us understand these concepts.

Memory Verse: The Lord directs the steps of the godly. He delights in every detail of their lives. 1 John 2:6

Heart of the Lesson: Looking Upward Means Preparing to Live in Heaven - John 14:1-3

Parent Connect: Today we learned that we need to be looking upward as we anticipate eternity in Heaven. We talked about how everything we do here on earth is important. Discuss with your kid, what is one thing that he/she wants to make sure to do in their time here on earth that will impact their time in heaven for eternity? Share with your kid one of your eternity focused goals.



This month we are looking at four aspects, the "DNA" of the church. We will look inward – how we help each other grow spiritually within the church outward – sharing Jesus with the world, upward – focusing our eyes on Jesus and Heaven, and backward – going back to the promise God made for the church.

Memory Verse: "Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near." Hebrews 10:24-25

Heart of the Lesson: Upward – The Church has an eternal hope in Jesus (John 14:1-6, Revelation 21:1-22:6)

Parent Connect: Heaven can be such an abstract concept to students at this age. Consider talking about Heaven over the dinner table as a family. Talk about what you think heaven will be like and look up scriptures to see what the Bible says about heaven. See if your ideas of heaven match up with what the Bible says.
