Am I a faithful messenger?

"And now, O priests, this commandment is for you. Malachi 2:1 NKJV

If you will not hear, And if you will not take *it* to heart, To give glory to My name," Says the Lord of hosts, "I will send a curse upon you, And I will curse your blessings. Yes, I have cursed them already, Because you do not take *it* to heart. **Malachi 2:2 NKJV**

Behold, I will rebuke your descendants, And spread refuse on your faces, The refuse of your solemn feasts; And *one* will take you away with it. **Malachi 2:3 NKJV**

Then you shall know that I have sent this commandment to you, That My covenant with Levi may continue," Says the Lord of hosts. Malachi 2:4 NKJV

"My covenant was with him, <i>one</i> of life and peace, And I gave them to him <i>thathemight</i> fear <i>Me</i> ; So he feared Me And was reverent before My name. Malachi 2:5 NKJV

Parent Engagement: Play a game of I Spy and talk about today's story - how Saul was blinded as he met Jesus (and later healed). If applicable, share your conversion story with your kids. How did you choose Jesus Lord in your life?

Jesus vs. The World



The world tells us a lot of things and if we aren't careful, it is easy to start listening to the world and acting like the world. The Bible tells us that God's kingdom is the opposite of the world and therefore the way we live should be different from the ways of this world. In this series, we are going to break down what Jesus tells us vs. what the World tells us. The victory is already won but you have to decide who you are going to let win in your life!

Memory Verse: Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect Romans 12:2

Heart of the Lesson: In God's Kingdom, It's About Our Savior Not Our Stuff - Matthew 9:9-13, Luke 9:23, Psalm 16:11

Parent Engagement: This week, start your morning with a simple prayer: "Jesus, what would you like me to focus on today, not what I want. Help me to follow you today." Follow up with how it went at dinner.

Parent Engagement: Have your student role-play how they would answer today's question if a friend asked them.
