Jesus is God's Beloved Son

God sent John the Baptist to prepare people for Jesus (Mark 1:1-8)

- The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. **Mark 1:1 NKJV**

- As it is written in the Prophets: “Behold, I send My messenger before Your face, Who will prepare Your way before You.” **Mark 1:2 NKJV**
- “The voice of one crying in the wilderness: ‘Prepare the way of the Lord; Make His paths straight.’ ” **Mark 1:3 NKJV**
- John came baptizing in the wilderness and preaching a baptism of repentance for the remission of sins. **Mark 1:4 NKJV**
- Then all the land of Judea, and those from Jerusalem, went out to him and were all baptized by him in the Jordan River, confessing their sins. **Mark 1:5 NKJV**
- Now John was clothed with camel’s hair and with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. **Mark 1:6 NKJV**
- And he preached, saying, “There comes One after me who is mightier than I, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to stoop down and loose. **Mark 1:7 NKJV**
- I indeed baptized you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.” **Mark 1:8 NKJV**

#### **God led Jesus through submission & temptation (Mark 1:9-13)**

- It came to pass in those days that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized by John in the Jordan. **Mark 1:9 NKJV**
- And immediately, coming up from the water, He saw the heavens parting and the Spirit descending upon Him like a dove. **Mark 1:10 NKJV**
- Then a voice came from heaven, “You are My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.” **Mark 1:11 NKJV**
- Immediately the Spirit drove Him into the wilderness. **Mark 1:12 NKJV**

- And He was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted by Satan, and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered to Him. **Mark 1:13 NKJV**

**Jesus began His public ministry by preaching & calling disciples (Mark 1:14-18)**

- Now after John was put in prison, Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, **Mark 1:14 NKJV**
- and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel." **Mark 1:15 NKJV**
- And as He walked by the Sea of Galilee, He saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. **Mark 1:16 NKJV**
- Then Jesus said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men." **Mark 1:17 NKJV**
- They immediately left their nets and followed Him. **Mark 1:18 NKJV**
- Then a voice came from heaven, "You are My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." **Mark 1:11 NKJV**

**"You are My beloved Son" implies connection**

**"You are My beloved Son" implies reflection**

**"You are My beloved Son" implies inheritance**

JESUS BLESSES THE KIDS



This month we are telling the story of Jesus blessing the kids (Mark 10:14-16). Your toddler is precious to Jesus, regardless of their age or influence. Help them see the mercy and grace God offers in Jesus to every person everywhere. Jesus loves each of us dearly.

**Memory Verse:** Jesus loves kids. Mark 10:14 (adapted for toddlers)

**Heart of the Lesson:** Jesus loves us all the time

**Parent Engagement:** Sometimes we make mistakes, but Jesus still loves us. This week as your toddlers make mistakes (it's bound to happen), be sure to remind him/her that you still love them and so does Jesus. Regular verbal reminders go a long way.

**Memory Verse:** "I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love." John 15:9

**Heart of the Lesson:** Jesus Does Miracles - Jesus fed 5,000 - Matthew 14:13-21

**Parent Engagement:** Did you know that a heaping 3/4 cup of uncooked rice is approximately 5,000 grains of rice? Place this amount of rice in a baggie to help your kids understand how large a crowd of 5,000 people really was!

How would you describe Jesus? Loving or condemning, kind or strict, friend or stranger? In the book of Mark, several groups of people describe Jesus and see Him in very different ways. **Memory Verse:** The disciples were absolutely terrified. "Who is this man?" they asked each other. "Even the wind and waves obey him!" Mark 4:41

**Heart of the Lesson:** Jesus is the son of God - Mark 1:9-11, Mark 9:2-8

**Parent Engagement:** This week we are talking about how God loves Jesus so dearly and is a proud father! Tell your kid something that you are proud of them for! Encourage kids to share their love for others out loud and their love for Jesus out loud just like God did.
