THE LORD'S PRAYER

In This series, we will be following along with the Adults to walk through The Lord's Prayer. We will go through the prayer verse by verse, learning about the example Jesus gives, how it applies to our lives and how we can pray. Students will also learn how to implement and practice the practical tips that Jesus shares: asking for forgiveness, praising God in prayer, thanking Him for supplying for our needs, praying for His kingdom to come and His will to be done.

Heart of the Lesson: God rescues us - Matthew 6:13

Parent Connect: Have you seen a picture of a kitten being rescued from a tree? Share with your student a situation that you have rescued them from something (a tumble when they were little, touching a hot oven, not great influences, etc). Then share how God has rescued you from your sin. (i.e. I used to make bad choices and not care what others thought. Now I try to pray before I make a decision and I care about what God wants for me, etc.)

Just like we want to talk to our close friends and family, God wants us to talk to Him! Prayer is what we call talking with God. But it can be confusing to know what to pray about! Luckily, Jesus showed us how! This series, we're looking at a sample prayer Jesus prayed to learn how we can pray!

Memory Verse: "This is how you should pray. "Our Father in heaven, may your name be honored. May your kingdom come. May what you want to happen be done on earth as it is done in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our sins, just as we also have forgiven those who sin against us. Keep us from sinning when we are tempted. Save us from the evil one.' [For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.] (Matthew 6:9-13)

Heart of the Lesson: Our Father guides and saves us (Matthew 6:13, John 10:27-29, 1 Corinthians 10:13, Hebrews 4:15-16, 2 Thessalonians 3:3-5)
