God sees generosity as a gauge for your heart

"For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." Matthew 6:21 NKJV

Now godliness with contentment is great gain. 1 Timothy 6:6 NKJV

For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. 1 Timothy 6:7 NKJV

And having food and clothing, with these we shall be content. 1 Timothy 6:8 NKJV

Parent Connect: Today we made beautiful butterflies crafts! Springtime is full of examples showing God's creatures in nature after a long winter. Take a walk outside and see how many creatures of the sky you can spy!

In this series we will learn about the miracle of Pentecost and the journeys of Peter and Paul as the travel to tell everyone about Jesus! Peter and Paul both experienced different journeys and different ways that they could tell others about Jesus!

Memory Verse: Mark 16:15 "And then He told them, 'Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone."

Heart of the Lesson: Saul Becomes a Christian | Acts 9

Parent Connect: Today we learned about Saul asks Jesus in heart after God blinds him. Saul knew he was wrong for the ways he had been treating people. Play a game of hide and seek with your kid and when you find them, shout 'Jesus Saves!'

ELEMENTARY DESCENDANTS EXPLORING OUR CONNECTION TO ABRAHAM

"Descendants" explores our connection to Abraham, revealing how Christians are part of his spiritual family. Through engaging stories and lessons, kids will discover the power of God's promises and learn how He faithfully keeps them. Heart of the Lesson: God Keeps His Promises In His Timing | Genesis 17 & 18

Parent Connect: Create an obstacle course and have your kid follow your directions carefully without them knowing the path of the obstacle course. Talk about how if they wouldn't have followed your instructions, they may have gotten hurt and wouldn't have known the end goal of the obstacle course. That's how we can follow God as well!

We are always looking around us. We can't help it. We see our lives and the lives of our friends and family around us. We know how our parents see us, how our teachers see us and how we see others. We don't often stop to look at how God sees us, sees our family, see our resources or success. We also don't always view these things in light of eternity. This month we will challenge ourselves to see things the way that God sees them as we keep our Eyes on the Eternal.

Memory Verse: "My thoughts are nothing like your thoughts," says the LORD. And my ways are far beyond anything you could imagine." Isaiah 55:8

Heart of the Lesson: Seeing Our Things as God Sees – God sees that our things are not eternal (Matthew 19:16-30)

Parent Connect: Together with your student look things you can donate to Freedom Fire (unused toys or games), or Church Under the Bridge clothing (for their clothing ministry) and as a family take time to donate both the items and your time to sharing what God has given you that you didn't either need any more or didn't need at all.
