Our spiritual enemies are the world, the flesh, & the devil Ephesians 2:1-3
(1) "The flesh" is our old sinful nature living in our bodies Romans 7:14-25
(2) "The devil" is the invisible network of fallen angels Ephesians 6:10-18
(3) "The world" is other people, society, and systems which foster sin 1 John 2:15-17

GOD MADE ME



Humans are the only beings described as being in God's own image. Psalm 139 shows how God's creative work in humans didn't end with the first two. He didn't just set things in motion and then ignore humanity. Instead, he knows each one of us and who we will become before we are even born. He created the very heart of us, the core of who we are. God knows us like no human could, and yet he cares for us and loves us!

Memory Verse: God made me. (adapted from Genesis 1:27-28)

ENTERING THE PROMISED LAND



Joshua and the Israelites were told they could "live in victory" in the Promised Land if they followed God's directions. We want our kids to know they can live in victory too if they follow God.

Memory Verse: This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord, your God is with you wherever you go. Joshua 1:9

Heart of the Lesson: Not Sure? Ask God! - Joshua and Gibeonites - Joshua 9

Parent Engagement Question: Do a magic trick or play the shell game with your family. How can your family make a habit of praying before making decisions so you won't be tricked like Joshua was?

ALL IN: LIVING IN VICTORY
