GOD MADE ME



Humans are the only beings described as being in God's own image. Psalm 139 shows how God's creative work in humans didn't end with the first two. He didn't just set things in motion and then ignore humanity. Instead, he knows each one of us and who we will become before we are even born. He created the very heart of us, the core of who we are. God knows us like no human could, and yet he cares for us and loves us!

Memory Verse: God made me. (adapted from Genesis 1:27-28)

Heart of the Lesson: God Made Me with Hands and Feet

Parent Engagement Question: Make a handprint turkey picture. Mail it to a grandparent or friend that lives far away.

Remind your toddler that God made his/her hands and feet!

God chose regular people to be heroes for Him. When you are following God He can choose you to be a hero for His people and lead others to follow God too.

Memory Verse: The angel of the Lord appeared to him and said, "Mighty hero, the Lord is with you!" Judges 6:12 NLT

Heart of the Lesson: Follow God - Deborah and Barak - Judges 4

Parent Engagement Question: Deborah made up a song after she and Barak led the people to victory. As a family make up your own chant/song about what you love about God and how He will take care of you family.

Because of Jesus, we are free to live in victory. As we dive into the book of Joshua, we are reminded of this truth and reminded that we are called to get in the game and actually play, knowing the battle is won as Jesus overcame death itself! We have a position on the winning team... God's team!

Heart of the Lesson: Know your position on God's team: Our inheritance - Joshua 13-17 & 1 Corinthians 12

Parent Engagement Question: Talk about the strengths and talents of each member of your family. How does those talents help your family function well? How can it help the family of God?

ALL IN: LIVING IN VICTORY

Heart of the Lesson: Stop and pray; don't be tricked: Gibeonites - Joshua 9

Parent Engagement Question: Do you believe that you have victory in Jesus? What mistake did Joshua and the Israelites make? What should you do to follow God's plan and not get distracted? Is it easy or hard to get tricked into questioning God and His plan?
