God uses us to encourage others

Tychicus, a beloved brother, faithful minister, and fellow servant in the Lord, will tell you all the news about me. **Colossians 4:7 NKJV**

I am sending him to you for this very purpose, that he may know your circumstances and comfort your hearts, **Colossians 4:8 NKJV**

with Onesimus, a faithful and beloved brother, who is one of you. They will make known to you all things which are happening here. **Colossians 4:9 NKJV**

And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, **Hebrews 10:24 NKJV**

not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching. **Hebrews 10:25 NKJV**

God uses us to pray for others

Aristarchus my fellow prisoner greets you, with Mark the cousin of Barnabas (about whom you received instructions: if he comes to you, welcome him), **Colossians 4:10 NKJV**

and Jesus who is called Justus. These are my only fellow workers for the kingdom of God who are of the circumcision; they have proved to be a comfort to me. **Colossians 4:11 NKJV**

Epaphras, who is one of you, a bondservant of Christ, greets you, always laboring fervently for you in prayers, that you may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God. **Colossians 4:12 NKJV**

For I bear him witness that he has a great zeal for you, and those who are in Laodicea, and those in Hierapolis. **Colossians 4:13 NKJV**

Luke the beloved physician and Demas greet you. **Colossians 4:14 NKJV**

Greet the brethren who are in Laodicea, and Nymphas and the church that is in his house. **Colossians 4:15 NKJV**

praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints— **Ephesians 6:18 NKJV**

and for me, that utterance may be given to me, that I may open my mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel, **Ephesians 6:19 NKJV**

Now when this epistle is read among you, see that it is read also in the church of the Laodiceans, and that you likewise read the epistle from Laodicea. **Colossians 4:16 NKJV**

And say to Archippus, “Take heed to the ministry which you have received in the Lord, that you may fulfill it.” **Colossians 4:17 NKJV**

This salutation by my own hand—Paul. Remember my chains. Grace be with you. Amen. **Colossians 4:18 NKJV**

who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began, **2 Timothy 1:9 NKJV**
