- John the Baptist's message – Matthew 3:11, Mark 1:8, Luke 3:16, John 1:33

Filled with the Spirit

- Happened before Acts 2 – Exodus 28:3, 31:3, 35:31, Luke 1:15, 1:41, 1:67, 2:40
- Happened to Jesus – Luke 4:1

- Happened to Peter repeatedly – Acts 2:4, 4:8, 4:31
- Happens to us repeatedly -- Ephesians 5:18

What did Jesus promise? (Acts 1:4-8)

And being assembled together with *them*, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, “which,” *He said*, “you have heard from Me; Acts 1:4 NKJV

for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.” Acts 1:5 NKJV

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” Acts 1:8 NKJV

What happened at Pentecost? (Acts 2:1-4)

When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. Acts 2:1 NKJV

And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. Acts 2:2 NKJV

Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and *one* sat upon each of them. Acts 2:3 NKJV

And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. Acts 2:4 NKJV

What did people hear? (Acts 2:5-13)

And there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men, from every nation under heaven. Acts 2:5 NKJV

And when this sound occurred, the multitude came together, and were confused, because everyone heard them speak in his own language. Acts 2:6 NKJV

Cretans and Arabs—we hear them speaking in our own tongues the wonderful works of God.” Acts 2:11 NKJV

What did Peter preach? (Acts 2:14-36)

Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ. Acts 2:36 NKJV

How did the people respond? (Acts 2:37-47)

Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Acts 2:38 NKJV

Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added *to them*. Acts 2:41 NKJV

And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. Acts 2:42 NKJV

Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. John 16:7 NKJV

Toddlers are just beginning to discover who they are — this is a wonderful time to share how special God made them! Toddlers seldom notice or care about cultural or physical distinctions. Have fun exploring with your kids the wondrous way God made each of us different and special.

Memory Verse: God made me. Genesis 1:27-28 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: God Made Me In His Image

Parent Connect: Today we learned that God made each of us in his image. Today's craft was an (unbreakable) mirror. Encourage your toddler to look in the mirror and say, "God made me".

Memory Verse: "John saw Jesus coming towards him and said, 'Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!'" John 1:29

Heart of the Lesson: The Holy Spirit Gives Us Power - Acts 2

Parent Connect: Your kid should have brought home activity sheets about Thailand and Romania. Look at the different languages. Discuss how they are the same and how are they different from English. Remind your kid about today's story when the disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit and started talking in different languages that they didn't even know. What would it be like to suddenly be able to talk in Thai or Romanian?



When Jesus left He gave His followers a mission to pass on the mission. However, He also promised to send a Helper - the Holy Spirit. With the power of the Holy Spirit, these early followers changed their world. That same Spirit is alive in us followers. Jesus wants to use us through the power of the Holy Spirit to change our world. What are you waiting for?

Memory Verse: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8

Heart of the Lesson: The Holy Spirit Gives Us Power - Acts 2

Parent Connect: Over dinner or a car ride, ask your kids who their favorite superhero is, why, and what makes them super. Relate this to the Holy Spirit. Remind your kids that the Holy Spirit is our guide, gives us courage, with us all the time, and helps us.
